MODULO 2

Unità 2 - 3

Funzioni linguistiche: talking about the family, describing the physical appearance of people, talking about likes and dislikes, agreeing and disagreeing.

Strutture grammaticali: verb have got present simple all forms; possessive case; plurals; possessive adjectives; adjective order; qualifiers: a bit, (not) very, quite, really; present simple: like + ing; play, do and go + ing; Which/what; connectors: and, but, or; object pronouns; so do I/I do.

MODULO 3

Unità 4 - 6

Funzioni linguistiche: Talking about daily activities, telling the time; talking about lifestyle; talking about present activities, temporary actions, on the phone; talking about the present; telling about food and quantities; talking about a diet.

Strutture grammaticali: Present simple all forms; expressions with have; the time; both; prepositions of time: at, on, in; adverbs and expressions of frequency; present continuous all forms; present simple vs

present continuous; time expressions: at the moment, this week; countable/uncountable nouns; how much/many; there is/are, some, any, a little/few, (too) much/many, a lot of, lots of, not enough .

MODULO 4

Unità 7 – 10

Funzioni linguistiche: Making requests and offers; making, accepting and refusing suggestions; talking about ability; talking about the past; talking about place and date of birth; asking for permissions and making requests; talking about holidays, using public transport.

Strutture grammaticali: would like/want to, let's, shall we, what/how about + ing, would prefer to, would rather, can, well/(not) very well, verb be past simple all forms, past time expressions (last night, ago ...), prepositions of place (at, in), was/were born, can/could/may, past simple regular/irregular verbs all forms, how long, present simple for future (timetables), who/what subject/object question, sequencers (first, then, next ...), every/some/any/no compounds.
