Unit 3 Talking about conditions

Grammar: First conditional (If I go....), time clauses (*when, as soon as, until, while, before, after*)

Vocabulary: Murphy's Law (photocopy), Shoes which control your TV (pg. 26)

Unit 4 Giving extra information, Describing places

Grammar: *Non-defining clauses: who, which, whose*

Unit 5 Past actions in progress

Grammar: *Past continuous, Past Simple and Past continuous (when, while, as...)*

Vocabulary: A perfect Crime (photocopy)

Unit 6 Talking about duration

Grammar: *Present Perfect (for, since), Present Perfect vs. Past Simple*

Vocabulary: Money and savings, Reading about Bono and Bob Geldof (pgs. 54 – 55)

Unit 7 Talking about unfinished actions, talking about skills, going for a job interview

Grammar: *Present Perfect Continuous (for, since), Present Perfect Continuous vs. Simple, adjectives + prepositions (keen on, good at,...)*

Vocabulary: I protested at Pamplona! (pg. 64), talking about cruelty to animals, a job interview, talking about jobs and pre-requisites, skills and personal qualities required

Unit 8 Describing processes, talking about local products and produce

Grammar: *Present Simple Passive*

Vocabulary: Chocoholics and chocolate (photocopy), talking about local products and produce

Unit 9 Talking about past habits, comparing ability, talking about lifestyles

Grammar: *used to, verb patterns, verbs + to or - ing*

Vocabulary: Kia Ora! – an article about New Zealand and the Maoris on pg. 86-87, I can't stop doing extreme sports on pg. 84

Unit 10 Giving advice, comparing ability, talking about lifestyles

Grammar: *should, ought to, you'd better..., if I were you,*

Vocabulary: illnesses and remedies

Unit 11 Imagining different situations, making wishes, talking about feelings

Grammar: *Second conditional,*

Vocabulary: *Talking about imaginary or unlikely situations, expressing emotions*
