Strutture: Will (predictions, future facts, promises) – May/might (future possibility) – I think/I'm sure/I hope/I believe – must/mustn't – Have to/don't have to – Past and future of must and have to – First conditional – When/as soon as unless – Defining relative clauses (who, which, that, whose) – Infinitive of purpose (to/for) – Must, may, might, could, can't for deductions - Non-defining relative clauses (who-which-whose-where) – May/might/must/could/can't.
