Starter Units

Grammar: to be, subject pronouns, possessive adjectives, indefinite articles, regular nouns, demonstrative pronouns, genitive, questions words, can.

Vocabulary: numbers, the alphabet, days of the week, countries and nationalities, compass points, everyday objects, colours, fast food and drink, money.

Function: give personal information, say hello and goodbye, order food and drinks.

Unit 1

Grammar: there is/are, definite article, some and any, prepositions of place.

Vocabulary: rooms, parts of a house and fittings, furniture.

Function: make and respond to requests.

Unit 2

Grammar: have got, plural and irregular nouns, prepositions of time.

Vocabulary: family, appearance, months and seasons, ordinal numbers.

Function: talk about your family.

Unit 3

Grammar: present simple, object pronouns, question words.

Vocabulary: jobs, places of work, adjectives of opinion.

Function: exchange opinions.

Unit 4

Grammar: present simple with fixed times, prepositions of times, adverbs and adverbial phrases of frequency.

Vocabulary: clock times, daily routines.

Function: express surprise and comment.

Unit 5

Grammar: can (ability), countable and uncountable nouns with some, any and no, imperatives, prepositions of place.

Vocabulary: verbs of ability, food, places in town.

Function: ask for help in a town.

Unit 6

Grammar: present continuous, present simple and present continuous, like/love/hate/prefer + ing.

Vocabulary: the weather, sports, free-time activities.

Function: make and respond to suggestions.

Unit 7

Grammar: past simple of verb to be, past simple of regular verbs, prepositions of motion.

Vocabulary: past adverbial phrases, years, adjectives of feelings.

Function: ask about problems.

Unit 8

Grammar: past simple of irregular verbs, past simple with ago.

Vocabulary: transport, holiday activities, landscape.

Function: talk about holidays.

Unit 9

Grammar: possessive adjectives and pronouns (whose...?), countable and uncountable nouns with much, many, a lot of, a few, a little, like and would like.

Vocabulary: money, everyday objects, common uncountable nouns, restaurant food.

Function: ask permission and respond, order food in a restaurant.

Unit 10

Grammar: comparative and superlative of short and long adjectives, Which + indefinite pronoun one/ones, too + adjective.

Vocabulary: short adjectives, adjectives of quality, clothes.

Function: shopping for clothes.

Unit 11

Grammar: to be going to, present continuous for future, want + infinitive, want + object pronoun + infinitive.

Vocabulary: types of music, adverbs.

Function: invite, accept and refuse.

Unit 13

Grammar: will for future predictions, first conditional, will for decisions/promises, will and shall for offers.

Vocabulary: computer language, faults.

Function: describe and deal with faults.
